PUBLIC HEARING

In accordance with Section 3-9 of the Leominster City Charter, a Public Hearing will be held on Monday September 11, 2023, at 6:50 P.M. in City Council Chambers, 25 West Street, Leominster MA, Massachusetts Electric Company d/b/a National Grid requests permission to locate poles, wires, and fixtures, including the necessary sustaining and protecting fixtures, along and across the following public way: Massachusetts Electric Company d/b/a National Grid and Verizon New England, Inc requests permission to locate poles, wires, and fixtures, including the necessary sustaining and protecting fixtures, along and across the following public way:

Mechanic St - National Grid to install 1 JO Pole on Mechanic St beginning at a point approximately 130' feet east of the centerline of the intersection of Johnny Appleseed Lane and continuing approximately 45 feet in a north direction. Install midspan pole approximately 40' west of Pole # 89-50 for new service from DOT traffic cameras on I-190. Location approximately as shown on plan attached.

Wherefore it prays that after due notice and hearing as provided by law, it be granted a location for and permission to erect and maintain poles and wires, together with such sustaining and protecting fixtures as it may find necessary, said poles to be erected substantially in accordance with the plan filed herewith marked- Mechanic St – Leominster - Massachusetts. No. 30611455 July 28, 2023.

Also, for permission to lay and maintain underground laterals, cables, and wires in the above or intersecting public ways for the purpose of making connections with such poles and buildings as each of said petitioners may desire for distributing purposes. Your petitioner agrees to reserve space for one cross-arm at a suitable point on each of said poles for the fire, police, telephone, and telegraph signal wires belonging to the municipality and used by it exclusively for municipal purposes.
