- 10-24 Susan Chalifoux-Zephir; Councillor At Large; Request to amend Chapter 7 entitled "Electricity," Section 7-5 "Placement of street lights over public ways," Paragraph (a) as follows: "(a) Any person or company desiring to construct a line, wire, pole or conduit utilized for the transmission of electricity shall, in writing, petition the city council to install said apparatus and wire dedicated to the illumination of a public way. A public hearing shall be held on the petition, and written notice of the time and place of the hearing along with a copy of the proposed plan shall be mailed at least seven days prior thereto by the clerk of the city to all owners of real estate abutting and abutters to the abutting real estate that are within 100 feet of the part of the way upon, along, across or under which the line is to be constructed, as such ownership is determined by the last preceding assessment for taxation. After said public hearing, the city council may, by order grant to the petitioner a location for such line specifying therein where the poles, piers, abutments or conduits may be placed, and in respect to overhead lines may also specify the kind of poles, piers or abutments which may be used, the number of wires or cables which may be attached thereto and the height to which the wires or cable may run.
